#### Rector's Corner:

Fall is upon us at St. Luke's. In October & November, the leaves are changing, the feast of All Saints has come and gone, the business of the annual bazaar is behind us, and Thanksgiving is around the bend. Advent is coming, calling on us to become prepared for Jesus Christ, to seek a space that allows us to "find and be found by Him". We are coming into the season when each of us needs to think about how we walk with God...live with God...and see the Messiah.

The measurement of an individual's spiritual life and character is not what he or she does in public moments, as much as how he or she lives in the private moments outside of the view of others. This is particularly true in the common and ordinary patterns of life. Walking with Jesus is hard work when we take the relationship seriously between ourselves and the Lord...and find that that he is moving a few steps ahead of us on the path to holiness and new life. We are called to be 'prepared' for a living relationship with Christ that nothing can separate us from. As St. Paul remarked in his letter to the Romans:

"Who shall separate us from the love of Christ! Shall tribulation or distress, or persecution, or famine, or nakedness or danger or sword? ...for I am sure neither death nor life, nor angels nor rulers, nor things present, nor things to come, nor power, not height nor depth, not anything else in all Creation, will be able to separate us from the love of God in Christ Jesus, Our Lord."

May it be so for all of us at St. Luke's in the coming weeks. The love and affection of heaven be with you.
